

Re: US Merchant Marine Veterans "Mission of Respect" with Prayer to Russia Christmas 2016

Dear Patriarch Kirill & Pope Francis:

After prolonged prayer with Faith in Christ I write to you to share our American veterans MA National WWII Memorial Committee's announcement of our "Mission of Respect" to Russia this Christmas 2016.

I write to request both of you as the Massachusetts Field Representative of the MA National WWII Memorial Committee, and along with the position I served previous which that service was recognized as the basis for my Congressional appointment to the WWII Memorial Committee by Cong. John Joseph Moakley. That previous position as the "Faithful Navigator" of the Rev. Robert H. Buchan 4th Degree Assembly Knight of Columbus may lend background information for your respective Offices to understand my fiduciary duty and the formation of our "Mission of Respect" to Russia with Prayer.

That includes our allies' communities that share our Judeo-Christian values. The duty of "Faithful Navigator" would not be listed in the CIA, KGB, or FSB files but I wanted to disclose a history for your joint edification the purpose of our "Mission of Respect" with prayer with the most esteemed respect for your leadership of the Faithful worldwide!

Within that duty to promote patriotism and "prayer" we request your support of our prayers for the millions of brave Russian Patriots interned at Piskaresvskoye Cemetery Memorial in St. Petersburg to honor with Interfaith Prayer on Christmas Eve day 12 noon to 6 PM, and midnight 12 PM to 6 AM prayer of the Rosary to Mary. Our "Mission of Respect" in St. Petersburg at the Piskaresvskoye Cemetery Memorial will be at those times daily & evening from Dec. 24, 2016 to Dec. 31, 2016 ending at sunset.

Our December 31, 2016 Evening Rosary to Mary will be recited on the train ride to Murmansk.

In addition we request your support for our "Mission of Respect" prayers for the American Merchant Marine who incurred the "highest casualty rate per capita of service" in WWII. A significant portion of those casualties were to keep the "lifeline of democracy alive" for our Russian allies in Murmansk. In honor of the brave American Patriots sacrifice we request your support for our prayers at the Alyosha Monument in Murmansk, Russia on January 1, 2017 with Interfaith Prayer from 12 noon to 6 PM and from midnight 12 PM to 6 AM prayer of the Rosary to Mary. Our "Mission of Respect" in Murmansk at the Alyosha Monument in Murmansk will be at those time daily & evening from January 1, 2017 to January 7, 2017.

On January 10, 2017 we will depart Russia to the United States for the historic inauguration of President Donald Trump in Washington D.C.

May Patriarch Kirill and Pope Francis accept our sincere "appreciation" for your historic meeting on Feb. 12, 2016 in Havana, Cuba. The blessing of your 30 Point Joint Declaration is a gift of hope and optimism this Christmas season for Christians throughout the world.

Be it known, that one (1) Point of the Joint Declaration, "The persecution of Christians in the Middle East" is inclusive to our "Mission of Respect" prayers in Russia. For within your Point of Joint Declaration of the "persecution of Christians in the Middle East" is a cause for a unified "mutual respect" between Russia & America as outlined in President Putin's kind "July 4th" message of "mutual cooperation" to the American people.

The central divisive wound of this "persecution of Christians in the Middle East," lies in Syria!

As Christians may we recall this Christmas 2016 the historical significance of Syria and the convert Saulus of Tarsus, known as Paul the Apostle.
